

## Silvies Valley Ranch Announces the Hiring of Two New Goat Caddies

Veteran caddies Bruce LeGoat and Mike LeChevon set to retire following the 2022 season as Chunky and Charlie join the ranks

**SILVIES, Oregon – July 27, 2022 –** <u>The Links at Silvies Valley Ranch</u> announced today that two new goat caddies have been added to the resort's staff. Chunky and Charlie were selected from over 300 young goats at the ranch all vying for a spot on the caddie team. Goat caddies are available to assist golfers on <u>McVeigh's Gauntlet</u>, the property's 7-hole challenge course that was named Best New Golf Experience by Golf Magazine in 2018. The stunning 7-hole course was designed as a fun yet challenging course to help players settle bets and test their accuracy on a series of undulating par 2, par 3, and par 4's.



While on duty, goat caddies carry up to six golf clubs, a dozen golf balls, golf tees, and six cans of refreshment, along with a few dozen peanuts for themselves. Silvies caddies are equipped with a custom goat caddie backpack designed by Seamus Golf.

"We are thrilled to welcome Chunky and Charlie to our team of caddies," said Sandy Campbell, head of the goat caddie program at Silvies. "Both of these guys have worked tirelessly to earn their spot on the staff, and they are sure to be adored by golfers and resort guests. After all, they never give any baaad advice on the course!" The ranch has the largest herd of organic meat goats in the world. The goats are used to help improve the sustainable environment at the ranch, and as a healthier alternative to other kinds of protein at the ranch's gourmet restaurant and other white tablecloth restaurants and homes in the region. The purebred American Range Goats are two - eight years old when caddying full time, and they work three to four days a week for about four hours per day.



The McVeigh Course is about a half-mile long, and goat caddies get a 20 minute break between rounds, along with a healthy snack of organic antelope brush and juniper. Golfers must take a short training course to have a caddie and are given a two-way radio for questions or to summon a human if any disagreements occur with their caddie.

Like all caddies, they have their own caddy shack (by the clubhouse) where they lounge around until they're called. At night, they have caddie quarters in the stable where guests can go visit and pet them.

The goat caddies are one of the many things that make Silvies unique. Recognized by <u>Golfweek</u>, <u>Golf Digest</u>, <u>GOLF Magazine</u> and <u>Golf Inc.</u> for its innovative approach to the golf experience, Silvies boasts both quality golf as well as the opportunity to connect with the land on a deeper level.
